The health literacy masterclass, led by Deakin's Health Systems Improvement Unit senior researcher Roy Batterham, will be held on Wednesday and Thursday.

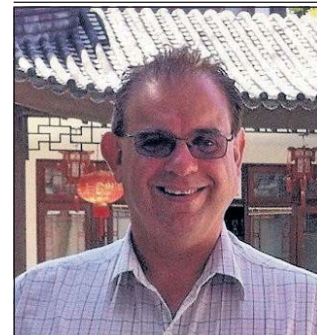
It will help managers, executives, health professionals, health planners, policy makers, researchers
